"At Well Sense, we have a robust care management department that works to meet all of our member's needs, which extend well beyond providing health insurance," said Solsky. We address the social determinants of health, such as food insecurities, substance abuse and homelessness, which create barriers to achieving health and well-being."

Well Sense has strong partnerships with both community agencies and providers to ensure that it meets the medical, social and emotional needs of members. It partners with community agencies that offer direct services aimed at breaking down barriers to achieving overall health and well-being.

This year, Well Sense supported 64 community agencies with upwards of \$80,000, including Child and Family Services of New Hampshire, the New Hampshire Food Bank and Families in Transition (FIT).
