SUBJECT: Billing and Claim Submission Requirements for Abortion Services

PRODUCT: New Hampshire Medicaid New Hampshire Health Protection Program

Summary

As a reminder, in accordance with our contract with New Hampshire Medicaid and 42 CFR 441.202, Well Sense Health Plan reimburses abortion services only if the pregnancy is the result of an act of rape or incest or in the case where a woman suffers from a physical disorder, physical injury, or physical illness, including a life-endangering physical condition caused by or arising from the pregnancy itself, that would, as certified by a physician, place the woman in danger of death unless an abortion is performed.

Providers must use modifier G7 on the procedure code and facilities must also report condition codes AA, AB, or AD on the claim.

New Requirement: In addition to your submission of claims (either electronically or on paper) as described above, Well Sense now will require physicians to submit a “Certification of The Decision to Terminate Pregnancy.” This form may be found in the provider Forms and Documents section on the Well Sense Health Plan website, wellsense.org/providers/resources/forms-and-documents. Claims and the Certification Form or other supporting attachments may be submitted electronically via our Well Sense provider portal.
